Subspecialty interest: General luminal including IBD.

At Glendon Wood Hospital, Dr Muthi sees: NHS Direct Access Flexi- Sigmoidoscopy and NHS Direct Access Gastroenterology on one Saturday a month. He also runs an outpatient clinic currently running on Monday mornings 08:00-12:00 with the hopes to move to Wednesday mornings as of January 2024.

03. **NEW SERVICE** - Robotic Surgery for Knee Replacements

In September we officially launched a new state-of-the-art robotic system for Self-Pay and Private Medically Insured patients requiring total knee replacement surgery. As a hospital we continue to invest in advanced medical technology for the benefit of our patients. The introduction of this pioneering technology will further enhance the hospitals services for private patients within the local community and further afield.

The robotic surgical assistant called the ROSA Knee system is now being used at the Woodland Hospital to enable surgeons to perform surgery with the utmost precision. As a result, patients will benefit from faster recovery, achieve a greater degree of joint flexibility and function, and are able to return to their normal activities quicker. In 2024, the ROSA system will also support hip and shoulder replacement procedures.

A private referral is required for patients who are potentially interested in robotic assisted surgery. Our consultants will then discuss with the patient if robotic surgery is appropriate.
