Self-pay Patients

Wherever possible, self-paying patients are offered a Total Care package price following initial consultation. This all-inclusive price includes all nursing and medical care, the hospital stay, consultants' fees and follow up consultations, giving patients the peace of mind of knowing that everything they need is covered.

Medical Insurance Company Policies

Rules regarding the accepted referral route for all conditions, including ophthalmic ones, are subject to change. It is therefore strongly recommended that, in line with Ramsay policy, all proposed treatment is pre-authorised in advance by both patients and the hospital. The respective insurer will then confirm if a separate GP referral is required or if an Optometrist referral is sufficient.

Aviva: Aviva will accept referrals to specialists from Opticians and Optometrists rather than requiring a GP referral. In these cases Aviva will often ask for sight of the referral letter from the Optometrist to ensure sight correction surgery using laser or lens exchange (which are standard policy exclusions) are not being recommended.

AXA PPP: AXA PPP will accept a direct referral from an Optometrist for cataract surgery. For all other ophthalmic conditions a GP referral is required.

Bupa: Bupa will accept a direct referral from an Optometrist for cataract surgery only. All other ophthalmic conditions continue to require a GP referral.

Cigna: Cigna will accept referrals from an Optometrist for acute conditions such as cataract surgery and chronic conditions such as glaucoma.

Vitality Health: Vitality Health allow referral direct from Opticians / Optometrists and should not require a separate GP referral.

WPA: Position partly depends upon the length of time the patient has been a member. For longer term members a direct referral from an Optometrist may be acceptable, but for others a GP referral will still be required. Pre-authorisation on a case-by-case basis is therefore strongly recommended.

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Diagnostic Services Available at Glendon Wood Hospital & Woodland Hospital

Below are some examples of specialist diagnostics we provide. All diagnostics are available for direct access for our Private Patients, however Self referring patients require a GP / Clinician referral letter and private medical insured patients require a referral / authorisation from their policy provider.

Ultrasound including:

- Venous lower and upper limb doppler for the investigation of limb swelling, suspected chronic deep venous insufficiency, suspected acute/chronic DVT
- Arterial doppler of the lower limbs for the investigation of suspected claudication or critical limb ischaemia; these can be done simultaneously with specialist referral
- Elastography for deranged LFT's or fatty liver
- MSK diagnostics EXCEPT interventional which would require orthopaedic referral
- Carotid doppler for suspected carotid disease (TIA, Amaurosis Fugax)
- Small bowel for Crohn's/inflammation
- For lumps anywhere
- · Groin and or Abdomen wall for hernia
- Gynaecology pelvis

MRI for routine and specialities including: Both our MRI systems are short and wide bore, making them patient friendly particularly for claustrophobic patients.

- Pelvic floor assessment
- Gynaecological assessment for pelvic pain and endometriosis
- Small Bowel for Crohn's/inflammation
- MR Proctograms for prolapse
- Multiparametric Prostate gold standard for Prostate MRI

CT including: Our CT service is at Glendon Wood Hospital. We put patients at ease and improve their experience, significantly lower radiation doses and Al-supported automation

- Sinus CT for suspected chronic rhinosinusitis.
- Mandible/Dental CT for assessment, abscess
- CT temporal bones for suspected chronic middle ear or mastoid disease.
- High resolution CT chest for suspected interstitial lung disease; breathlessness of unknown origin.
- Abdominal pain and abdominal symptoms
- CTC for CIBH with raised FIT and patient not suitable for or doesn't want Colonoscopy.



Physiotherapy at Glendon Wood Hospital

The Physiotherapy Department is staffed by professional and experienced clinical Chartered Physiotherapists. We work to Physiotherapy Chartered Society Standards supporting best practice and will strive to provide the best in patient care.

The department contains 6 spacious physiotherapy treatment rooms as well as a large fully equipped gym. All physiotherapy patients have a treatment plan established on assessment by their physiotherapist, which is regularly reviewed during the course of physiotherapy treatment.

Private and self funded patient referrals are accepted from GPs and Allied Professionals. Self paying patients may refer themselves for physiotherapy. Discharge reports are sent to the patient and the referrer when the patient has completed treatment. Packages of care can be provided for patients with long term rehabilitation requirements.

NHS patients can be referred by GPs to an orthopaedic consultant who dependent upon assessment, could than be referred to physiotherapy for shockwave therapy or acupuncture. If an NHS patient has a surgical or steroid injection procedure following the orthopaedic consultation then the consultant can refer to physiotherapy following the procedure.


